We are really looking forward to a fantastic and action-packed Summer Term. Our topic is Rainforests. Please see our attached curriculum overview for information about the exciting things we have planned in each subject.

Trips and experiences

On **Monday 3rd June** we are being visited by the brilliant **Zoolab** who will be bringing live rainforest creatures for the children to observe and handle whilst teaching them all about adaptation, the function each animal has within the rainforest, the layers of the rainforest and different habitats and ecosystems within them.

On **Wednesday 26th June** we will be going on a trip to **Drusillas Park** where, as well as exploring the amazing variety of different rainforest species at the zoo, children will take part in a workshop in their themed rainforest room. This session will use images, artefacts and live animals to further explore the biodiversity of tropical rainforests, and the importance of conserving these unique environments.

The total cost of these experiences for the whole term is **£21 per child** and payment can be made using school money.

If you would like to help on our visit, please let the office know. As we are limited on numbers of adult helpers because of coach space, we will confirm with you as soon as possible if we need you to accompany us.
